

## SDR DECORATION GUIDELINES

- The ranch does not decorate your wedding for you, but we will guide your décor committee if needed.
- The large shelf in the Heritage against the long wall will be decorated by season and we really try to leave those up there.
- You can remove items from the fireplace mantel and the piano, but it must be put back.
- The "Native American Wall" can be covered but not taken down.
- You cannot put nails in the wall or any structure on the property. You can use wire ties, command hooks, or other fasteners that come off and leave no damage.
- You may use real candles as long as you have something to catch the wax. Candles should have a broad base.
- SDR does NOT provide candles. If you need candles, please bring them with you.
- You cannot throw fake petals on the property.
  - Fake flowers/foilage ends up in the river and we can be **fin**ed by Parks & Wildlife for this, we will pass that fine onto the wedding that left the petals.
- You can NOT have confetti in the reception space.
- Having sparklers will depend on the state of Colorado fire bans.
- If you bring large furniture, you must take it with you.
- If you rent tables or chairs they need to be dropped off and picked up while you're on property.
- If you rent sashes for your chairs, someone from your party will tie them.
- If you rent napkins, we will fold them.
